# **DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY**

to per- and polyfluorinated alkyl compounds PFAS (per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances)

#### Ladies and Gentlemen

this declaration is made with reference to the 6 directives and regulations listed below, as there is no uniform legal position on PFAS. The declaration is based on our current state of knowledge. We are in constant contact with our suppliers in order to always be able to provide up-to-date information about the ingredients in our products. As soon as we become aware of any deviating information, we will inform you of this immediately.

## Regulation (EC) 1005/2009 on substances that can damage the ozone layer

We confirm that none of the substances listed in Regulation (EC) 1005/2009 are contained in our products.

## **Stockholm Convention**

We confirm that none of the substances listed in the Stockholm Convention are contained in our products. In Europe, the Stockholm Convention has been transposed into European law by Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 (EU POP Regulation). For more information see our separate document on the POP Regulation.

#### **Rotterdam Convention**

The Rotterdam Convention on the Prior Informed Consent Procedure for Certain Hazardous Chemicals and Pesticides in International Trade (PIC Convention) came into force on February 24, 2004. We confirm that none of the substances listed in the Rotterdam Convention are contained in our products.

## Canadian Environmental Protection Act, 1999 (CEPA)

We confirm that none of the substances listed on the "List of Toxic Substances (LOTS) - last amended on 2021-05-01" are contained in our products.



# Japan - Chemical Substances Control Law (CSCL)

As part of the CSCL, manufacturers and importers of chemicals must report them and create an annual report. Our products are exclusively articles that are not affected by the requirements of the CSCL.

## US-TSCA "significant new use rules (SNURs)".

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) Issued Significant New Uses (SNURs) regulations for chemicals that were the subject of Pre Manufacture Notices (PMNs). This mainly affects manufacturers and importers of chemical substances - in particular companies from the chemical processing industry.

While not affected by this regulation, we note that we are not aware of any substances in our products that are affected by TSCA's Significant New Uses (SNURs) regulations.
